Faith that Gives God Glory

Main Idea: Strong Faith Gives God Glory. When you are strong in faith this brings Glory to God.

Romans 4:19-20

And being **not weak in faith**, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb: He **staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief**; but was **strong in faith, giving glory to God**;

- 1. Strong Faith doesn't consider the circumstances.
- 2. Strong Faith doesn't deny the Facts.
 - Abraham never denied that he and his wife Sarah were beyond child bearing age.
 Instead, Abraham believed God's Truth
 - i. Truth is what is available to believers that comes from God!! Irt comes from spiritual places. Truth is divine reality based on God's perspective that never changes
 - ii. Facts are what is determined to be real by physical senses.
- 3. Strong Faith doesn't deny reality. Instead, it trusts that God can change the reality.
- 4. Strong Faith doesn't doubt God's ability to bring the promises to path.
 - a. Abraham never doubted the promise of God.
 - i. When we doubt God's promises, we step into the realm of unbelief.
 - 1. Unbelief is the refusal to believe and trust God. Unbelief will not cancel God's promises, but it will stop you from receiving them.
- 5. Strong Faith doesn't rely on sense knowledge.
 - a. There are two types of knowledge: Sense Knowledge and Revelation Knowledge.
 Strong Faith relies on revelation knowledge
 - Sense Knowledge is knowledge that operates through the 5 senses and excludes God and the Bible Revelation Knowledge is knowledge that is revealed to use through God's Word
