Salvation is not a destination, it's a door to a new life under new management. God can't really save your life unless you let Him **LEAD** it.

We are **Saved from Sin**.

We are **Saved for the Promises of God**.

Salvation has 3 elements

- God has saved us from the Penalty of sin (Justification)
- God has saved us from the Power of Sin (Sanctification)
- God will save us from the presence of sin (Glorification)

**Justification**

- Romans 5:1
  - To justify means to declare righteous or to be put into right relationship
  - Through Justification, God has done 3 things
    - Forgave our sins (Acts 13:38-39)
    - Removed our guilt (Romans 8:1)
    - Imputed Righteousness (Romans 4:5-6)

**When does Justification happen? When you believe**

**Sanctification**

- To sanctify means to set apart or declare holy
  - Titus 2:14
- There are 3 Phases of sanctification
  - Instantaneous (Standing)- 2 Thessalonians 2:13, 1 Corinthians 6:11
  - Progressive sanctification (Spiritual Growth) - 2 Peter 3:18
  - Ultimate Sanctification (State) 1 Thessalonians 5:23

**When does sanctification happen? As you live**

- **1 Thessalonians 5:23; Romans 12:2**

**Glorification**

- Glorification relates to the completion of salvation
  - Romans 8:16-18

**When does glorification happen? When we see Jesus**

Romans 8:30 And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.
