Salvation has 3 elements

- God has saved us from the Penalty of sin (Justification)
- God has saved us from the Power of Sin (Sanctification)
- God will save us from the presence of sin (Glorification)

Sanctification

- To sanctify means to set apart or declare holy
- There are 3 Phases of sanctification- Instantaneous, Progressive, Ultimate
 - Progressive sanctification (Spiritual Growth) – 2 Corinthians 6; 2 Peter 3:18
 - Why is there progressive sanctification?
 - We are Triune- Spirit, Body, Soul
 - Genesis 2:7
 - Ephesians 2:1
 - Our spirit was dead before Christ. Our soul was in charge. When we give our lives to Christ, Christ makes our spirit alive!
 - Romans 12:2
 - In transformation, our soul (Mind) must submit to our spirit.
 - In this transformation we continue to grow, this growth brings glory to God. Growth brings God Glory
 - Ultimate Sanctification (State)

When does sanctification Happen? As you live

- **1 Thessalonians 5:23**

Glorification (Ultimate Sanctification)

- Glorification relates to the completion of salvation

When does glorification happen? When we see Jesus

- Romans 8:16-18
- Romans 8:30 And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.
 - As we have suffered with God, we will one day reign with Him
 - This reign climaxes at the last judgment when the believer's body is reunited with the soul and shares in the soul's power and authority. Sin, death, the devil, and the world will be under our feet.
