Glory Series: Show me your Glory

Exodus 33:18 (NIV) Then Moses said, "Now show me your **glory**."

Glory - Hebrew word Kabod which means weight- intensity -substance

- Moses already knew the Lord and had favor with the Lord (Verse 12),
 Experienced the Burning Bush (Exodus 3), Opening of Red Sea (Exodus 14),
 Bread from Heaven (Exodus 16), Water from a Rock (Exodus 17),
- In Exodus 13, Moses Prayer is "Lord I know what you have done, but I want more (Your glory).
 - Moses had a hunger and appetite for more of God.
 - Hunger Need
 - Appetite Desire

3 D's for Appetite

- 1. Desire
- 2. Distortion
- 3. Direction
- Your appetite (Desire) was created by God but was distorted by sin.
- Philippians 2:13
 - Genesis 3:6
 - Matthew 4:2
 - Satan has always tried to distort God's creations.
 - Your Image of God
 - Your Identity in God
 - Satan always attacks your identity in God.
 - Satan's initial strategy is to take a legitimate God given desire (appetite) in our lives and twist into something illegitimate. Sin occurs when we try to fulfill (appetite) this desire our own way.
- Your appetite can never be fully satisfied by worldly, earthly things
 - Matthew 5:6
 - The evidence of desire is pursuit. It is only when you go in the direction of God and the things of God that you will be filled.
