- Paul- Ephesians 1:1= I, Paul, am writing this letter. I am an apostle of Christ Jesus just as God planned. I am sending this letter to you, God's people in Ephesus. Paul was in prison. In prison for preaching the gospel
- Written to the church in Ephesus that Paul planted
 - The church in Ephesus had a major impact on the lives of people
 - O Acts 19:11-18 Cast out demons
 - Acts 19:19-20- Burned books of magic
