## Worry vs. Trust Part VIII

- Worry and Trust are mutually exclusive.
  - It is impossible to trust and worry at the same time.
- Psalm 37:3
  - Don't worry about the wicked or envy those who do wrong. Trust in the Lord and do good;
    - Doing what is right in God's eyes mean to obey God
      - It is impossible to obey God if you don't trust Him

What does it mean to Trust God?

1<sup>st</sup> we must understand this:

## Trusting God is a choice, not a feeling!!

- Psalm 56:11
- Trusting God means
  - <u>Allowing</u> God to take Control
    - Worry can often give you the illusion of control.
      - Illusion of Control- Trying to be in control of everything
  - o <u>Acknowledging</u> God's ability
    - When things happen that are out of your control, we must rely on God's Ability.
    - How do I acknowledge God's ability?
      - Be Available- God doesn't need you to be able, He needs you available
      - God didn't call you because you could, He called you because He would do it through you.
        - Exodus 4:12
        - o Matthew 10:20
  - Accepting What God has done
  - Then Accepting What God has done
  - Proverbs 3:5-6
    - We can Trust God even though we may not understand God. We have to accept what God is doing even when we don't understand.
    - Understanding is not a perquisite to Acceptance.
    - The true test of trust is to obey God even when you don't understand.
